General Instructions

Presentations

Presentations are organized in panels which will contain 4 participants on average. The presentation should not exceed 15 minutes; it is followed by a short debate, not longer than 10 minutes. You may use a whiteboard; an overhead projector and a PC (for PowerPoint presentations) for your presentation (bring your presentation on a USB flash disc).

Food

You can have some small refreshment in the registration room throughout the day. There will be a lunch break from 12:30 to 14:00 and you may have lunch at the University restaurant “Academic Club” (reasonable prices – 4-7 EUR for lunch), at café bar “Deštník” (reasonable prices – 3-7 EUR for lunch, New Building – ground floor) or at university canteens (3-4 EUR for lunch, Paradise Building – ground floor). There are of course other possibilities around the University, the organizing team will gladly give you advice.

In the evening, all conference participants are cordially invited to a glass of wine accompanied with hors d’oeuvres/appetisers.

There are also some grocery shops in and near the hall of residence and near the University as well, open until late evening hours.

Accommodation

For the participant who need the accommodation, it will be booked at the University Hall of Residence JAROV in single/double rooms en suite.

Regrettably, we are not able to cover the costs of the accommodation. However the prices are moderate:

single room – 505 CZK per person per night

double room – 425 CZK per person per night
